Dear Applicant:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that Department of Ecology (Ecology) is initiating coordinated cost-reimbursement processing of all pending applications for new water rights in the Wenatchee Basin.

Our records show that you have an application on file to change an existing water right. Because the cost-reimbursement process involves only pending applications for new water rights, your application to change an existing water right will not be considered as part of this cost-reimbursement process. However Ecology is required to notify you under RCW 90.03.265 that this processing is taking place. Your application will remain on file with Ecology and under RCW 90.03.380(5), your application and existing water right will not be affected by this process.
