Briefly describe the purpose of your proposed project: The proposed right would authorize the allocation of 100.8 acre feet of the 166.27 acre feet of consumptive use for ground water permits for a mix of multiple individual or group domestic wells within the Yakima River Basin downstream from Thorp and particularly the areas of Kittitas County as described in Exhibit 1, such permits to be water budget neutral by mitigation water to be allocated from Certificate of Trust Water Right No. CS4-01724CTCLsb7. The permits would be for in-door, non-irrigation use only, not to exceed 250 gpd per ERU or such greater or lesser quantities as may from time to time be permitted. Up to 1200 ERU's would be allowed based upon .084 acre feet of consumptive use per ERU per year.


