RE: Ground Water Application No. G4-31724 - **AMENDED TEMPORARY PERMIT**

Due to the Sunlight Waters Country Club's immediate need to provide an adequate water supply to meet the public health and safety requirements for current lot owners, it has been determined that a **TEMPORARY PERMIT** can issue. In accordance with the provisions of Sections 90.03.250 and 90.44.020 of the Revised Code of Washington (RCW), you may consider this letter to be an **AMENDED TEMPORARY PERMIT**, which replaces the **TEMPORARY PERMIT** issued May 21, 1993, subject to the following limitations and provisions:

1. The priority date of this **AMENDED TEMPORARY PERMIT** is May 11, 1993.
2. The source of water withdrawn under this **AMENDED TEMPORARY PERMIT** shall be two wells located within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, and/or the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25, Township 19 N., Range 16 E.W.M.
3. Water withdrawn under this **AMENDED TEMPORARY PERMIT** will be used to supplement the continuous community domestic supply authorized under Ground Water Certificate No. 7532-A but will authorize the additional instantaneous pumping capacity required to meet peak water demands and fire flow needs beyond that authorized under Ground Water Certificate No. 7532-A.
4. The total maximum quantity of water authorized to be withdrawn under this **AMENDED TEMPORARY PERMIT** and Ground Water Certificate No. 7531-A shall not exceed 250 gallons per minute and 50 acre-feet per year. Sunlight Waters Country Club is responsible for metering and tracking the total amount of water withdrawn at the source to insure that the 50 acre-foot per year limit is not exceeded. Based on 1996 water use records, a total of approximately 48 acre-feet were used by Sunlight Waters Country Club. If each connection uses 300 gallons per day, four additional connections could bring water use for the system up to the maximum quantities authorized.
5. The place of use is the Sunlight Waters Country Club located on the parcel described as follows:

That part of the E $\frac{3}{4}$ of Section 24 lying southerly of the Yakima River; and that part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25 lying northerly of the right-of-way of Interstate Hwy 90, Less: Beginning at a point 230 feet south of the northwest corner of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, on south line of Thorp Prairie Road; thence along said south line S 74°06' E, 173 feet and

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S 57°40' E, 187 feet and S 50°33' E, 84 feet to a point on the west line of the Elk Heights Road; thence S 70°12' W along said line 99.1 feet to the north line of the access road of Interstate Hwy 90; thence westerly along said line to the west line of said NE¼NW¼; thence north to the point of beginning; Less roads and rights-of-way.

6. This **AMENDED TEMPORARY PERMIT** is subject to the State of Washington Department of Ecology Minimum Standards for Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells, (Chapter 18.104 RCW and Chapter 173-160 Washington Administrative Code).
7. Installation and maintenance of an access port as described in WAC 173-160-355 and Ground Water Bulletin No. 1 is required. An airline and gage may be installed in addition to the access port.
8. This **AMENDED TEMPORARY PERMIT** shall in no manner be construed to guarantee or even imply that a final (regular) permit will issue pursuant to the subject application.
9. This **AMENDED TEMPORARY PERMIT** will remain in effect until such time that it is determined a final decision can be made as to the disposition of Ground Water Application No. G4-31724.

This Order may be appealed. Your appeal must be filed with the Pollution Control Hearings Board, PO Box 40903, Olympia, WA 98504-0903 within thirty (30) days from the date this Order was mailed. At the same time a copy of your appeal must be sent to the Department of Ecology, Water Resources Program, c/o Appeal Coordinator, PO Box 47600, Olympia WA 98504-7600. Your appeal alone will not stay the effectiveness of this Order. Stay requests must be submitted in accordance with RCW 43.21B.320. These procedures are consistent with Chapter 43.21B RCW.
