This June 30, 1889 priority water right was exercised fully (0.20 cfs, 54 af/yr of water from the Teanaway River, for irrigation of 10 acres from May 1 through September 15 each year) by the Istvans prior to their sale of the water right to the US Bureau of Reclamation in a sale that closed on September 28, 1999. This water right was subsequently confirmed in this quantity by the Yakima Adjudication Court's entry of the Conditional Final Order (CFO) for Subbasin No. 3 (Teanaway River) on February 8, 2001.

The Adjudication Court entered an "Order Pendente Lite Re: Seaton Water Users Association Members, Teanaway River Ranch Associates Water Users, Teanaway Ranch Inc., and Barbara L. Istvan Trust, Water Rights, Teanaway River, Kittitas County" on March 9, 2000. This Order Pendente Lite (OPL) transferred the full amount (100%) of this water right to instream flow enhancement use in the Teanaway River at the original Masterson Ditch and Seaton Ditch authorized points of diversion (POD). This OPL further protected the consumptive use portion of this water right for instream flow enhancement use below the authorized Masterson Ditch and Seaton Ditch POD's in the Teanaway River downstream to its confluence with the Yakima River and then downstream in the Yakima River to the Yakima River's confluence with the Columbia River.

The US Bureau of Reclamation operates and maintains a stream flow gaging station on the lower Teanaway River along SR 970, the "Teanaway River above Lambert Road" gage. Court-appointed stream patrolman Stan Isley (see the Court's 8/27/98 OPL Re: Metering, Measuring and Reporting Requirements, Teanaway River and Big Creek, Kittitas County) monitors the USBR stream flow gage and tracks this Reclamation/former Istvan instream flow water right to ensure it is exercised and protected for its authorized instream flow use each year. It is fully exercised each year.

Masterson Ditch POD: 900 feet south and 350 feet east from the north quarter corner of Section 25, being within the NW¼NE¼ of Section 25, T. 20 N., R. 16 E.W.M.
Seaton Ditch POD: 1200 feet south and 600 feet west of the east quarter corner of Section 26, being within the NE¼SE¼ of Section 26, T. 20 N., R. 16 E.W.M.
This application requests Ecology's long-term assignment of 100% of this USBR/former Istvan irrigation water right to the State Trust Water Rights Program for instream flow enhancement use in the Teanaway and Yakima and Columbia Rivers, under a long-term renewable term basis, as defined in the MOA currently being negotiated between Reclamation and Ecology that will define each agency's roles in joint management of Yakima Basin trust water rights. Ecology's placement of this water right into the State Trust Water Rights Program on a long-term renewable basis will act to partially satisfy the common instream flow enhancement goals of each agency, in perpetuity, under the federal Yakima River Basin Water Enhancement Project (YRBWEP) Act and the State Water Acquisition Program.
This water right is the second of two irrigation water rights Reclamation YRBWEP acquired from the Barbara L. Istvan Trust on September 28, 1999. The two water rights total 0.40 cfs, 108 af/yr, for irrigation of 20 acres from May 1 through September 15 each year. Both water rights were confirmed by the Court's 2/08/01 CFO for Subbasin No. 3, and both were entirely transferred to instream flow use by the Court's 3/09/00 OPL. Reclamation is concurrently filing another trust water application for the first of the two Reclamation/former Istvan water rights and requests that Ecology place both of the two Reclamation/former Istvan water rights into the State Trust Water Rights Program for instream flow enhancement trust water right use in the Teanaway and Yakima and Columbia Rivers.
The priority date of this water right is June 30, 1889.
