Re: Ground Water Application No. G4-31220 - TEMPORARY PERMIT

Due to your immediate need to use water, it has been determined that a TEMPORARY PERMIT can issue. In accordance with the provisions of Sections 90.03.250 and 90.44.020 of the Revised Code of Washington (RCW), you may consider this letter to be a TEMPORARY PERMIT which is issued subject to the following limitations and provisions:

1. The priority date of this TEMPORARY PERMIT is April 19, 1992.
2. The point of withdrawal being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6, T. 8 N., R. 28 E.W.M. in Benton County.
3. Water is to be used for continuous community domestic supply and irrigation within the following described lands: Lots 1, 2, 3, and 4 of Short Plat No. 1031, 1032, 1033, 1042, and 1043 of Section 6, T. 8 N., R. 28 E.W.M., within Benton County.
4. This TEMPORARY PERMIT is subject to the State of Washington Department of Ecology Minimum Standards for Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells, Chapter 18.104 RCW (Chapter 173-160 Washington Administrative Code).
5. This TEMPORARY PERMIT shall in no manner be construed to guarantee or even imply that a final (regular) permit will issue pursuant to the subject application.
6. This TEMPORARY PERMIT will remain in effect until a final decision is made on Ground Water Application No. G4-31220.
