Earlier this year, the Department of Ecology issued an Emergency Drought Authorization under the above-referenced application number for the use of emergency wells in the Yakima River basins to supplement reduced deliveries during this irrigation season. In some cases new wells were approved for this purpose.

One of the provisions of the authorizations was that a flow meter must be installed, water use monitored, and the water use records submitted to the department at the end of the irrigation season. At this time, I am writing to request the metering reports on these wells. If you did not drill a well that was authorized, or did not use water that was authorized, please let us know.

My staff will be conducting end of irrigation season field visits in the near future. Your meter records and information on the completion of new wells is greatly appreciated.

This letter is in response to your letter of concern regarding Mr. Glover's drought well. Both Mr. Glover and Mr. Mahre have received drought emergency authorizations through this department for the use of the well this year.

This year, each of the drought authorizations require the water user to monitor and record their water use. Ecology staff have visited most of the water users who have been issued drought authorizations, including Mr. Glover, and we are confident that he is monitoring his water use and will report the water use at the end of the irrigation season.

The issue of them using a pipeline that is on your property is a civil matter between you and your neighbors and not something Ecology would get involved in.

Dear Ecology,

Mr. Glover is pumping water through a 4 inch pipe to Tim Mahre Orchard with the drought well provision. I did not see an adjudication of this additional water that is depleting my aquifer. Mr. Glover pumps for his orchard too. He has been pumping this drought well and I question who is monitoring this well and other wells and read their flow meters each year. There are other wells like the Eberhart well (not a drought well) that pumps and sells water in previous years. Mr. Glover pumps this water to Mahre through my pipe, which is 60 years old and rusty without my permission.

I am waiting for a permit to drill a well for my land and houses that has been filed since 1993. This is taking water away from me in the future if I ever get one. I am under KRD too and my water went off the first of August so I don't have a means to water my orchard but I do hope the trees stay alive.

Isn't it breaking the law for Mr. Glover to do what he is doing?
