The SW¼NE¼ and that portion of the SE¼NW¼ of Section 25, T. 40 N., R. 40 E.W.M., in Stevens County, Washington, lying East of Schriber Creek. EXCEPT beginning at the center of said Section 25, from which the East quarter corner thereof bears North 88°05'44" East 852.63 feet; thence leaving said South line, North 35°23'19" West 879.05 feet; thence South 41°21'12" West 647 feet, more or less, to the centerline of Schriber Creek; thence along the centerline of said Schriber Creek, Southerly 260 feet, or or less, to the South line of the SE¼NW¼, of said Section 25; thence leaving said creek centerline and along the South line of said SE¼NW¼ N. 88°06'57" East 95 feet, more or less, to the Point of Beginning.

### Provisions

#### Measurements, Monitoring, Metering and Reporting

An approved measuring device shall be installed and maintained for each of the sources identified by this water right in accordance with the rule "Requirements for Measuring and Reporting Water Use", WAC 173-173.

WAC 173-173 describes the requirements for data accuracy, device installation and operation, and information reporting. It also allows a water user to petition the Department of Ecology for modifications to some of the requirements.

#### Department of Fish and Wildlife Requirement(s)

The intake(s) shall be screened in accordance with Department of Fish and Wildlife screening criteria (pursuant to RCW 77.57.010, RCW 77.57.070, and RCW 77.57.040). No dam or weir shall be constructed in connection with this diversion.

#### Water Use Efficiency

The water right holder is required to maintain efficient water delivery systems and use of up-to-date water conservation practices consistent with RCW 90.03.005.

#### Proof of Appropriation

The water right holder shall file the notice of Proof of Appropriation of water (under which the certificate of water right is issued) when the permanent distribution system has been constructed and the quantity of water required by the project has been put to full beneficial use. The certificate will reflect the extent of the project perfected within the limitations of the permit. Elements of a proof inspection may include as appropriate, contracting with a Certified Water Right Examiner (CWRE) to confirm the source(s), system instantaneous capacity, beneficial use(s), annual quantity, place of use, and satisfaction of provisions.

**Schedule and Inspections**


Department of Ecology personnel, upon presentation of proper credentials, shall have access at reasonable times, to the project location, and to inspect at reasonable times, records of water use, wells, diversions, measuring devices and associated distribution systems for compliance with water law.

This permit shall be subject to cancellation should the permittee fail to comply with the above development schedule and/or to give notice to the Department of Ecology on forms provided by that Department documenting such compliance.
