Dear Ms. Ryf:

This letter is in response to our recent meeting on June 24th, concerning the Port of Moses Lake's interest in acquiring Quincy Basin (QB) Water Permit.

In order to start the process of establishing a place holder for such permits, we are enclosing our Application for Permit to Use Artificially Stored Ground Water. This water usage will be required for the further development and expansion of the Port's existing Waste Water Land Application System. The amount of ground water requested is 4,400 gallons per minute, or a maximum of 2,249 acre feet per year.

This additional water will be used for property that is being acquired from the Bureau of Reclamation. The land transfer is expected to be complete on, or before, September of 2014. Upon completion of the land sale and transfer, we can sign as the Legal Landowner.
