Dear Mr. Beach:

In response to your request, you are hereby granted an extension to put the water to full beneficial use for the reason(s) below:

According to your request, you have been unable to put the project to full beneficial use due to economic conditions. You have requested an additional two years to put water to beneficial use. **Be advised that the State Water Code requires that your project be pursued with diligence and does not allow, through the permitting process, the reservation of water for use at an unspecified time in the future. It is important that your project be put to full beneficial use within the time prescribed in the authorization.** It appears you have made goals in putting water of full use. Your request of extension will be reduced to a reasonable time for a project of this scale. We will grant you an additional year to put the water to full beneficial use. According to the information provided, this will complete your project.

The new deadline to submit your *Proof of Appropriation of Water* is November 1, 2010.

It is very unlikely we will extend this project beyond November 1, 2010.

You have a right to appeal this decision. To appeal this you must:

- File your appeal with the Pollution Control Hearings Board within 30 days of the "date of receipt" of this document. Filing means actual receipt by the Board during regular office hours.
- Serve your appeal on the Department of Ecology within 30 days of the "date of receipt" of this document. Service may be accomplished by any of the procedures identified in WAC 371-08-305(10). "Date of receipt" is defined at RCW 43.21B.001(2).
