PRIMARY REACH


The Trust Right for the primary reach is from Mill Creek beginning at the original point of diversion (approximately River Mile 6.7, within the SE¼SE¼ of Section 19, Township 7 N., Range 36 E.W.M.) and ending at the terminus of the channelized flood control zone (approximately River Mile 4.7, within the SE¼SE¼ of Section 23, Township 7 N., Range 35 E.W.M.).

Provisions

Consistent with RCW 90.42.080(1)(a), this trust water right shall be managed by Ecology as an instream flow right for Mill Creek.
