ONE (1) GROUND WATER CERTIFICATE

TAKE NOTICE:

That Isaak Land, Inc. of Coulee City, WA, had^{5/} made application for change/transfer of water right in order to add four points of withdrawal and change the place of use as granted under Ground Water Certificate No. 1476-A.

That Certificate No. 1476-A authorizes the withdrawal of 600 gallons per minute, 640 acre-feet per year for the seasonal irrigation of 160 acres.

That the authorized point of withdrawal is from one well located within the S $\frac{1}{2}$ S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec. 16, T. 25 N., R. 30 E.W.M.

That the authorized place of use is described as the S $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and S $\frac{1}{2}$ W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec. 16, T. 25 N., R. 30 E.W.M.

That they propose to add four points of withdrawal. That after the changes, they will have five wells located as follows: 1) S $\frac{1}{2}$ S $\frac{1}{2}$; 2) NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; both within Sec. 16, T. 25 N., R. 30 E.W.M; 3) SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 15; 4) NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 10; both within T. 24 N., R. 29 E.W.M; and 5) SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 34, T. 25 N., R. 29 E.W.M.

That the proposed place of use is described as follows: 144 acres within the S $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 16, T. 25 N., R. 30 E.W.M; 16 acres within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 11, T. 24 N., R. 29 E.W.M.

All within Grant County, Washington.

The Department of Ecology has received your water right change applications. Please include the numbers above if you contact us regarding your applications.

Processing your applications

Generally, we group applications by watershed and process them in the order submitted. It will be some time before we begin working in your area. When we start evaluating applications in your watershed, we will prepare public notices and send them to you with publication instructions. Filing an application does **not** give you permission to make the requested changes.

While your change applications are on file awaiting a decision, water use must continue as authorized under the existing water rights. Nonuse for a period of five consecutive years may be cause for relinquishment. You may review the relinquishment statute at <http://apps.leg.wa.gov/RCW/default.aspx?cite=90.14.140>.

Alternative process: Water Conservancy Boards

Due to the heavy volume of water right applications currently filed with Ecology, we want to be sure you are aware of another option for processing changes to existing water rights: *Water Conservancy Boards*. A board may be available in your county. They provide initial processing of water right change applications at the local level, for Ecology's review. 




Map based on Application for Change/Transfer of a Water Right received 4/29/2009

Dear Mr. Isaak:

We received the above-referenced applications for change in our office on April 14, 2009, together with your check number 3024 in the amount of \$500.00. At this time, our office cannot formally accept your applications.

As of July 25, 2005, a new law under RCW 90.03.470 has increased the fees for applying for water right applications and storage applications as well as changing how fees for water rights, water storage and dam safety inspections are calculated. The fee to change, transfer or amend an existing water-right certificate, permit or claim is \$50.00 plus an additional 50 cents per one hundredth cfs of water over one cfs. Therefore, the fee for these applications is \$1,183.34. Minus your \$500.00 check received, the additional amount required is **\$683.34**. I've enclosed a focus sheet describing the new water-right fees for your review.

Before we can accept and process your applications, we will need the additional required fees in accordance with RCW 90.03.470.

You are required to obtain a water right change authorization before you can exercise your requested change/transfer, **please note that no construction or water use should begin before a water right change authorization is obtained.**


