Re: Application for Change/Transfer under Ground Water Certificate G3-23978C

On January 30, 2013 our office received from the Spokane County Water Conservancy Board a Record of Decision for the above referenced application for change/transfer. In accordance with RCW 90.80.080 the Department of Ecology has reviewed the Record of Decision and Report of Examination and has considered all comments, protest, objections, and other relevant information.

The Department has **affirmed** the decision of the Board and the proposed change/transfer of water right is **approved**.

- Serve a copy of your appeal and this document on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) Email is not accepted.



In accordance with RCW 90.80.080 and WAC 173-153-150, our office received the records of decision referenced above on Jan. 30, 2013. The department will review the records of decision and affirm, reverse, modify, or remand the actions of the board by March 16, 2013.

However, the director may invoke, or the board or applicant may request, a 30-day extension beyond the date listed above as allowed under RCW 90.80.080(4). The department will notify all necessary parties should an extension be required.

If Ecology does not act by the date listed above, the water conservancy board must notify Ecology, the applicant, and any parties that have expressed interest about the applications of Ecology's failure to act [WAC 173-153-150(11)]. With agreement from Ecology, the board's decisions become final.
