The 220 Volt underground power lines to power the new water pump which were installed many decades ago and are feed from our homestead residence power service supply. Existing water pump will be replaced with a jet pump or a submersible pump with an approved fish protecting intake screen.

About 1/2 down Martin Creek Drive there is a horse shoe curve to the left and two mail boxes on the right and a road sign on the right Dry Dock Court, this is the beginning of a private roadway servicing the our homestead and lots 13-17 of MCCA. Stay to left of Y at gate with Eagle and fish. White home with green roof.
