 Proposed Water System will be constructed to supply water for domestic and irrigation uses within the proposed development of the Three Rivers Property. The proposed development will include 500 residential (cabin) sites, a 9-hole golf course, a club house with a pool, and an RV Park with 100 spaces. The system will include two well pumps, distribution piping, and storage facilities. The first well will provide water supply to approximately 270 residential units in the western portion of the development. The first well will require a pumping capacity of approximately 114 gpm to meet projected water demands. The second well will provide water supply to approximately 230 residential units, the golf course, club house and RV Park in the eastern portion of the development. The second well will require a pumping capacity of approximately 256 gpm to meet water projected water demands. The wells have not been drilled and water system plans have not been developed.

To second well site, follow NF Road 25 north approximately 1 mile. Turn right on Loowit Lane. Follow Loowit Lane approximately 0.9-miles to well site.
