Dear Ms. Brown:

The City of Rainier, is requesting an extension of the development schedule for Water Right Permit No. G2-28841 to be put to full beneficial use. The date specified by Permit No. G2-28841 for proof of appropriation was November 1, 1996. A previous extension set the date for proof of appropriation to November 1, 2006.

The City of Rainier Well No. 3, the point of withdrawal specified under Water Right Permit No. G2-28841, is currently equipped and is fully utilizing the 200 gpm allocated instantaneous capacity of the water right. The well also regularly utilizes the 50 ac-ft/yr of primary annual right allocated under Permit No. G2-28841. However, the City has **not yet fully utilized the total annual primary plus supplemental quantity of 160 ac-ft/yr** under this plus other rights to which the supplemental portions of this right pertain.

The City of Rainier has not yet grown to the extent suggested in the Report of Examination for Permit No. G2-28841, and full buildout with full beneficial use of this right will take additional time. Due to the pace of construction, we are requesting extension of the date for full beneficial use of this right until November 1, 2016. Per your letter of March 8, 2007, we are enclosing a check for \$50.00 for the extension fee, payable to the Department of Ecology. This extension should enable the City of Rainier to meet the intent of the permit and more fully utilize its resources as growth continues. Dear Sir or Madame:

In reviewing your file, I noticed we have not received your Proof of Appropriation form. A previous reminder letter was sent on **December 27, 2006**, to which there was no response. This letter is to remind you that the development schedule of your water right permit required that water at full beneficial use and the Proof of Appropriation form submitted by **November 1, 2006**.

There are a number of possible steps you may need to take in order to bring your permit back into good standing, depending on the status of your project. Please refer to the following chart:

If this is the case:	You need to do this within sixty (60) days of the date of this letter:
You have put the water to full beneficial use .	Complete and submit the Proof of Appropriation form. The form must be <u>notarized</u> , and include the parcel number for the point of withdrawal/diversion. Please include evidence that shows you have installed an approved measuring device, as well as any metering data that you have collected on the above-referenced water.
You need more time to put the water to beneficial use.	1. Submit a written request for an extension (refer to enclosed fact sheet for instructions). 2. Submit extension fee (\$50.00).
You no longer intend to develop your project.	Notify Ecology's Southwest Regional office in writing.
You need more information.	Contact our office at (360) 407-6300.

If we do not hear from you within sixty (60) days of the date of this letter, your permit will be in jeopardy of cancellation without further notice.
