The water will be used for continued support of facility operation (industrial use and fire control), and planned expansion. The water will be withdrawn using the existing groundwater well, fitted with a 30-hp, 3-phase submersible pump rated at 350 gpm, and a 4-inch-diameter lift pipe. The water will be temporarily stored in an existing 450,000-gallon holding tank, located immediately north of the well. No drillers log exists for this well.

Hampton Lumber Mills will also install a second, back-up supply well in the same parcel, with the same construction details and capacity as the existing well.


