Thank you for the opportunity to talk to you last week, I am including information on a Cost-Share program that is available through Ecology, the program allows you to apply for reimbursement on money spent on a meter. I am also including information on meter vendors, (most will service western Washington), and technical information on meters that may be of interest.

To complete the Proof of Appropriation process and issue a water right certificate, we will need metering data reflecting the actual use of your water system. To give yourself adequate time to install a meter and collect the data, you will need to apply for an **extension of the permit's development schedule**. It is recommended that you record at least one year's worth (if not more) of data to get a clear idea of how much water has been put to full beneficial use.

In compliance with your request, you are hereby granted an extension of time until **October 1, 2008**, to put the water to full beneficial use and file a notice of such action under the above mentioned permit.

Please submit the following when the actual water has been put to full beneficial use:

- Proof of Appropriation form filled out and notarized
- \$21.00 check payable to the Clark County Auditor's Office
- \$5.00 check payable to the Department of Ecology

Please send both checks to the Department of Ecology and we will forward the Auditor check along with your Certificate to the County Auditor's Office for recording. **Also, the County Auditor is requiring that we have the parcel number for your property added to your Certificate. Please provide the parcel number for the point of withdrawal/diversion and the place of use.**

If you do not expect to have the water put to full beneficial use by **October 1, 2008**, you should request further extensions, as needed. To request additional extensions, you will need to submit a letter explaining why an extension is needed, including how many more connections are proposed on this water system. You may extend for more than one year at a time at a rate of \$5.00 per year.

This order may be appealed. Your appeal must be filed with the Pollution Control Hearings Board, PO Box 40903, Olympia, WA 98504-0903 within thirty (30) days of the date this Order was mailed by the Department of Ecology. At the same time a copy of your appeal must be sent to the Department of Ecology, c/o Water Resources Appeal Coordinator, PO Box 47600, Olympia, WA 98504-7600. Your appeal alone will not stay the effectiveness of this order. Stay requests must be submitted in accordance with RCW 43.21B.320. These procedures are consistent with Chapter 43.21B RCW.

Thank you for taking the time to show Vicki Cline and I around your property on May 29, 2003. As we discussed, your Water Right Permit S2-26222 requires that it be extended under 90.03.470(7) Revised Code of Washington (RCW).

The Proof of Appropriation for your water right permit was due on October 1, 1994. The statutory fee for completing the application of water for irrigation on 53 acres is five (5) dollars each year multiplied by 14 years is \$70. This will extend your permit until October 1, 2008.

Based on the information you provided us during our site visit, we are allowing an extension of five years to complete the final stage of putting the water to beneficial use. Measuring how much water is used on an annual basis for irrigation is of particular interest to Ecology during this time.


A metering provision will be required under 90.03.360 RCW and 173-173 WAC and, as such, will be included in the provisions of your final water right certificate. Enclosed is information regarding water usage and metering requirements.

Memo To File

June 3, 2003

This Memo to File is an explanation as to why we are extending Martin Curtis' Surface Water Right Permit S2-26222 for an additional five years.

For approximately 10 years Ecology has unsuccessfully been able to contact Mr. Curtis regarding the filing of a Proof of Appropriation form. December 29, 1989 was the last contact via a telephone conversation with Sheri Fox of Ecology's Southwest Regional Office, whereby Mr. Curtis had verbally confirmed completion of construction. A Proof of Appropriation form was due on October 1, 1994, I have extended his permit until October 1, 2008.

On April 30, 2003 Mr. Curtis called and verified his interest in the permit. A site investigation was done on May 29, 2003 with Vicki Cline, and confirmed a large portion of land (approximately 53 acres) with Timothy Hay as the crop being cultivated. Mr. Curtis was very sincere and helpful in explaining the intentions of how he will use the water.

Over the past years Mr. Curtis suffered from a variety of illnesses that would not enable him to focus his efforts on the land. It was only until this year that he has resumed cultivating the hay. He requested that we extend the permit for five years due to the restructuring of the irrigation system so that he could install a meter and begin taking readings. In addition, his health is improving but due to his incredulous stories regarding previous health issues I decided that five years is deemed appropriate under the circumstances.

Metering information, copies of his permit and ROE, and a letter dated June 3, 2003 were sent to Mr. Curtis regarding this issue.

This letter is a follow-up to our phone conversation on December 7, 2000. At that time, I faxed a copy of your permit, and you indicated you would send a completed Proof of Appropriation form to our office within a week. To date, we have no record of receiving the form for the above-referenced permit.

The Proof of Appropriation form is to be filled out when all the water has been put to full beneficial use and all the provisions have been met. You may complete and file the Proof of Appropriation form for less water than authorized in the permit, if the project is complete and less water is being used than anticipated. The information on the form should accurately reflect what you are using the water for now, and should include how much water is flowing from the creek to the pond. We are now requiring that your water source be metered. Your certificate will be provisioned for continued metering.

Once the form is completed and notarized, return it to this office along with the recording fees. The statutory recording fees are to be sent in as **two separate remittances** in the form of checks or money orders. Cash will NOT be accepted. Send both remittances to the Department of Ecology.




