In response to your request, you are hereby granted an extension to complete construction for the reasons below:

Your new deadline to complete construction and send a Completion of Construction form is **September 1, 2014**.

You have a right to appeal this decision. To appeal this you must:

- File your appeal with the Pollution Control Hearings Board within 30 days of the "date of receipt" of this document. Filing means actual receipt by the Board during regular office hours.
- Serve your appeal on the Department of Ecology within 30 days of the "date of receipt" of this document. Service may be accomplished by any of the procedures identified in WAC 371-08-305(10). "Date of receipt" is defined at RCW 43.21B.001(2).

Be sure to do the following:

- Include a copy of this document that you are appealing with your *Notice of Appeal*.
- Serve and file your appeal in paper form; electronic copies are not accepted.

Thanks for your call this morning. I talked it over with Jerry and we want to keep the extension dates at 5 years each, so if you take the extra \$35 from G2-27900 (Classic Hts) amount I sent in, which was \$70 total, and apply it to Permit G2-27623B (Aspinwall), I will send you in another check this week for an additional \$30, which will make a total of \$65 to cover the 5 year extension for this permit. I only sent \$65 to cover the extension for G2-27623A for 5 years and I should have sent in \$65 for each A and B. Sorry for the confusion! I hope this clears it up. Thanks!

> Hi, Judy. Thanks for sending the extension fees and requests for Classic Heights and Aspinwall Estates. Unfortunately there is some discrepancy with the fees. However, I think I have a solution. Please let me know if it will work for you.

>
> The extension fee for Classic Heights Well #2 (G2-27900), is more than the amount required to extend the permit to 2007, per your request. Despite the fact that the well has not been constructed yet for Classic Heights Well #2, our records show the permit is in the completion of construction phase of development. Therefore, only a \$5.00 per year fee is required. To extend the permit from October 1, 2000 to October 1, 2007, the fee would be \$35.00. You submitted a check for \$70.00.

>
> Conversely, the extension fee for Aspinwall is less that what is required for your request. Our file for the Aspenwall Estates contains two permits, G2-27623A and G2-27623B. Therefore, your request to extend both permits from September 1, 1995 to September 1, 2007 would require a fee of \$130.00 (\$65.00 each). You submitted a check for \$65.00.

>
> To untangle the fee discrepancy, I suggest that we move \$35.00 from the extension request for Classic Heights #2 (G2-27900), to the Aspinwall permits. This would bring your total fee to \$100.00, which would allow you to extend the two permits to September 1, 2005 (instead of 2007).

>
> If you agree to this suggestion, I will recommend that we grant the extensions with the amended dates for the Aspinwall permits. I will include this e-mail and your e-mail reply with the files.

>



1. A description of efforts you have made since the permit was issued or the last extension was granted to complete construction.
2. An anticipated time schedule for completing construction and completing development of the water system.
3. Reason(s) for needing the extension.
4. Any additional remarks concerning your project that will assist us in making our decision of whether to grant the extension.
5. Check or money order for the **\$40.00** extension fee made payable to the Department of Ecology, at \$5.00 a year this would bring you current until **September 1, 2002**. Payments of extension fees are non-refundable regardless whether the extension is granted.




