is hereby granted a permit to appropriate the following described public ground waters of the State of Washington, subject to existing rights, and to the limitations and provisions set out herein.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY ON WHICH WATER IS TO BE USED

PORT OF OLYMPIA AIRINDUSTRIAL TRACT NO. 2, described as follows:
Beginning at the northwest corner of Sec. 10, T. 17 N., R. 2 W.W.M., running thence southerly along the west line of said Sec. 10 to its southwest corner; thence easterly along the south line of said Sec. 10 to a line parallel to and 1550 feet westerly from the center-line of Runway 17-35, the Olympia Airport; thence northeasterly along said line to the west line of the east 500 feet of said Sec. 10; thence northerly along said line to the north line of said Sec. 10; thence westerly along the north line of said Sec. 10 to the point of beginning; EXCEPTING THEREFROM that part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 10 described as beginning at a point on the north line of said Section, 1874.58 feet west of its northeast corner and running thence west along said north line 209 feet and thence south 209 feet, east 209 feet and north 209 feet, to the point of beginning; EXCEPTING ALSO from Sec. 10, a 300-foot wide tract conveyed to the State of Washington for Primary State Highway No. 1 by deed dated May 4, 1954, and recorded under File 535186; EXCEPTING ALSO the north 660 feet of the west 30 feet of Lot 1 of said Sec. 10 and the north 30 feet of that part of said Lot 1 of Sec. 10 lying westerly of said Primary State Highway No. 1; and EXCEPTING ALSO that part of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 10 lying southwesterly of the northeasterly right of way line of Prine Road.

Particular specifications required by the Supervisor of Water Resources for the purpose of preventing waste of public waters: As provided under R.C.W. 43.21.130, 90.03.360 and 90.44.020, a master meter, individual service meters or other suitable measuring devices shall be installed in this system to measure the total amount of the withdrawal. Records of total monthly withdrawal shall be maintained by an official, responsible for the management and operation of this water system, and after certificate of water right issues, this information shall be reported each year to the Supervisor of the Division of Water Resources. A standard form for reporting such information shall be sent annually to the manager of the system.

Construction work shall begin on or before December 1, 1966
