

Attached please find a check for \$100.00 for a five (5) year extension of these two permits from April 1, 2010 to April 1, 2015.

The Inlet Heights water system is owned by Washington Water Service Company (Washington Water). It is Washington State Department of Health approved to serve 15 ERU's. The Aspinwall Estates water system that serves 20 ERU's is nearby and is also owned by Washington Water. These two systems share an emergency intertie that was the precursor to the eventual consolidation of these two systems with a third system – Simmons Court. These permits are a part of that consolidation effort. Consolidation of these three systems is temporarily on hold, necessitating this request for extension.

Consolidation of these systems awaits improvement in local economic and real estate market conditions such that the cost of consolidation is adequately offset by resulting residential in-filling. Until the residential construction environment changes completion of this consolidation project is temporarily suspended. It should be noted that the intertie, which was the first phase of this consolidation project, is currently only opened during extreme emergency such as a power outage, broken water line or the failure of pumping equipment that would otherwise result in a service outage and risk to public health.

We are optimistic that within the next five years the economic conditions needed to revitalize this project will return so that this project that also enhances system reliability can be completed.





While checking the progress of your water rights, I noticed that you have not sent in the Proof of Appropriation Forms.

If you are using the full amount of water shown on your permits, please fill out the enclosed Proof of Appropriation forms, have them notarized, and returned to this office. The statutory recording fees are to be sent in as two separate remittances in the form of checks or money orders. Cash will NOT be accepted. Send both remittances to the Department of Ecology.

\$10.00 payable to the Department of Ecology
AND
\$42.00 payable to the Thurston County Auditor

Also, the County Auditor is requiring that we have the parcel number(s) for the point of withdrawal/diversion and the place of use if different. Please send those numbers to us with your recording fees.

By following the above instruction, your final water right will be prepared, sent to your County Auditor for recording, and then forwarded to you by your County Auditor.

In addition, one of the provisions of the permits is that a metering device be installed and that meter readings be recorded at **least monthly**. Please include meter readings for a least the past year with the completed Proof of Appropriation forms.

If more time is required to put the water to full use, you should request an extension of time in writing. By statute, a **\$5.00 fee per year must accompany such a request, together with a showing of good cause why your extension should be granted and a report of progress made during the last year**. The Proof of Appropriation for your water right permit was due on **April 1, 2005**, if an extension is needed, please send **\$10.00** payable to the Department of Ecology along with your request to extend your files until **April 1, 2006**.

If we do not hear from you within **thirty (30) days** from the date of this letter, we shall be forced to assume that you are no longer interested in retaining the permits, and action will be taken resulting in cancellation.




