
Approximate location of diversion: 400 feet south and 1650 feet east of NW corner of Sec. 20.

This application is for temporary donation of the entire remaining portion ("Record A") for instream flow purposes. The temporary donation term is until further notice. Donor retains the right to make the donation permanent.


