Dear Mr. Kane:

In response to your request, you are hereby granted an extension to begin construction for the reason(s) below:

According to your request, you need additional time to obtain funds to construct the well. In addition, health problems have slowed down the development of your project. It appears that minimal progress has been made on this project. Be advised that the State Water Code requires that your project be pursued with diligence and does not allow, through the permitting process, the reservation of water for use at an unspecified time in the future. It is important that construction of your project begin within the time prescribed in the authorization. Your requested extension is a reasonable period of time. We will grant you an additional five years to begin construction of the project.

The new deadline to submit your *Construction Notice* is **September 1, 2021**.

Water use data shall be recorded monthly and maintained by the property owner for a minimum of five years. The maximum rate of withdrawal and the annual total volume shall be submitted to the Department of Ecology by January 31st of each calendar year. Recorded water use data shall be submitted to the Eastern Regional Office.

YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this action to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this document. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).



To appeal, you must do the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this document:

- File your appeal and a copy of this document with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this document on Ecology in paper form, by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) Email is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
