Dear Mr. Simmons:

This letter is in response to your extension requests to the above-referenced Change Authorizations. The original Certificates were issued in 1983 and 1987 respectively. Subsequently, Ecology received applications requesting to add points of diversion and withdrawals and the development schedules required that the Completion of Construction stage be completed by April 1, 2004, and water was to be put to full beneficial use by April 1, 2005. Since then Ecology has granted two extensions of time, citing that more time was needed due to metering hardware difficulties, upgrading meter system, etc.

As evidenced by the history of this file, the progress of fulfilling the development schedule has been unreasonably slow, but Ecology recognizes your recent efforts with Tom Perkow, Columbia River Watermaster with regards to Change Authorization No. CG4-29877P, and understands how the three Change Authorizations are related. Therefore, in response to your request, you are hereby **approved** an extension of time for the reasons below:

- Efficiencies must be reanalyzed.
- Pumping capacities are being reviewed by a private contractor.

Be advised that where due diligence has not been shown, the State Water Code does not allow the reservation of water for use at an unspecified time in the future.

The new deadline to submit your *Construction Notice* is **April 1, 2011**.

For technical assistance related to metering, please contact Eiko Urmos-Berry at 509- 575-2397. For general permitting assistance, please continue to work with Mr. Perkow. He can be reached at 509-662-0512.

You have a right to appeal this decision. To appeal this you must:

- File your appeal with the Pollution Control Hearings Board within 30 days of the “date of receipt” of this document. Filing means actual receipt by the Board during regular office hours.



- Serve your appeal on the Department of Ecology within 30 days of the “date of receipt” of this document. Service may be accomplished by any of the procedures identified in WAC 371-08-305(10). “Date of receipt” is defined at RCW 43.21B.001(2).

Be sure to do the following:

- Include a copy of the document that you are appealing.
- Serve and file your appeal in paper form; electronic copies are not accepted.


