Dear Mr. Sinclair:

In response to your request, you are hereby granted an extension to begin construction for the reason(s) below:

According to your request, a design for the proposed well has been completed. Additional time will be required to obtain funds and to complete the logistics of constructing the well. It appears that minimal progress has been made on this project. Be advised that the State Water Code requires that your project be pursued with diligence and does not allow, through the permitting process, the reservation of water for use at an unspecified time in the future. It is important that construction of your project begin within the time prescribed in the authorization. Your requested extension is for a reasonable period of time. We will grant you an additional year and a half to begin construction of the project. If additional time is required beyond this extension, your project will be reevaluated at that time for compliance with due diligence.

The new deadline to submit your *Construction Notice* is **June 1, 2015**.

YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this action to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this document. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal, you must do the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this document:

- File your appeal and a copy of this document with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this document on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) Email is not accepted.



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You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
