Dear Mr. West:

In response to your request, you are hereby granted an extension to complete construction for the reason below:

- Nature and scope of project.

The new deadline to submit your *Construction Notice* is **January 30, 2014**.

The Department of Ecology may amend a Permit's provisions when that Permit receives an extension to its development schedule. This authority rests in Ecology's *POL-1050: Extension of Time on Permits*, "Conditions may be imposed on a permit extension beyond what was provided in the original permit and Report of Examination." Therefore, as a condition of the extension approval, the following requirements are added:

- Submit lease agreement or other documentation showing specific number of acres in production.
- Lease agreement for 14.5 acres within state land.
- Submit invoice for or farm plan outlining total remaining acres pending production.
- Submit financial receipts demonstrating expenses made for wells, power, mainlines, and roads for irrigation infrastructure to also include a copy of the wire transfer on May 2, 2012.

The Superseding Permit currently requires that, "By January 31st of each year, a spreadsheet documenting the acreage appurtenant to this water permit shall be submitted to Ecology's Central Regional Office (CRO)." This provision cannot be changed and is a requirement of the Permit. Therefore, please submit by January 31st and every January 31st thereafter.

As a side note, with regards to the supplemental information mailed Ecology dated December 26, 2012; we are **not** yet in receipt of an assignment for a portion of this Superseding Permit. Please advise.



YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:

- File your appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this decision on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
