Re: Water Right No. G2-27770 for High Banks Water System

Dear Mr. Jones:

In response to your request, you are hereby granted an extension to put the water to full beneficial use for the reasons below:

- Due diligence is shown in development of this permit. Five of the eight lots have been developed and are using water.
- Additional time is needed to develop the remaining three lots due to poor real estate market and economic conditions.

The new deadline to submit your *Proof of Appropriation of Water* is **October 1, 2017**.

Please note that Permit G2-27770 requires you to install a meter on your well and to measure withdrawals monthly. It also requires you to monitor and report chloride and conductivity levels twice a year, during the months of April and October. As a condition of this extension, you must comply with the provisions of your permit and submit metering, chloride and conductivity data to our office by January 31st of each year.

By January 31, 2014, you must submit the following to our office:

- Chloride and conductivity testing results from April and October, 2013.
- Metering data for Calendar Year 2013.
- All available chloride, conductivity and metering data collected previously.
- A completed *Measuring Device Information* form.

YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:



- File your appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this decision on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
