Re: Application for Change under Ground Water Certificate No. 6798-A(A)

Dear Mr. Menozzi:

In response to your request, you are hereby granted an extension to complete construction for the reason(s) below:

According to your request, you are currently serving active military duty for the US Air Force and are stationed in Alaska. You have requested additional time so you can complete your project when you are again living in the Walla Walla area. It appears you have made goals in completing your project and are pursuing it with diligence. Your request is for a reasonable period of time. We will grant you an additional five years to complete your project.

The new deadline to submit your *Construction Notice* is **September 1, 2016**.

Water use data shall be recorded weekly and maintained by the property owner for a minimum of five years. The maximum rate of diversion/withdrawal and the annual total volume shall be submitted to the Department of Ecology by January 31st of each calendar year.

WAC 173-173 describes the requirements for data accuracy, device installation and operation, and information reporting. It also allows a water user to petition the Department of Ecology for modifications to some of the requirements.

Department of Ecology personnel, upon presentation of proper credentials, shall have access at reasonable times, to the project location, and to inspect at reasonable times, records of water use, wells, diversions, measuring devices and associated distribution systems for compliance with water law.

#### **YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL**

You have a right to appeal this action to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this document. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).



To appeal, you must do the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this document:

- File your appeal and a copy of this document with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this document on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) Email is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
