Dear Mr. Smith:

In response to your request, you are hereby granted an extension to put the water to full beneficial use for the reasons below:

- Due diligence is shown in development of this project. Olympic Water and Sewer is currently serving 1,530 residential services on this water system. The wells under this water right supplied 22% of total system production in 2015.
- Additional time is needed for full beneficial use of water due to local economic conditions and the magnitude of this project for municipal supply purposes.

The new deadline to submit your *Proof of Appropriation of Water* is **August 1, 2021**.

Permit G2-27492 requires you to submit chloride and conductivity data from Well 14 or 16 by January 31<sup>st</sup> each year. In accordance with your permit provisions, sampling must occur during the month of September, concurrent with measurement of the static water level, and the water quality analysis must be performed by a state-accredited laboratory. September 2016 chloride and conductivity testing results are due *by January 1, 2017*, and may be sent electronically to the e-mail address below.

#### **YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL**

You have a right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:



- File your appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this decision on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.


You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
