Re: Applications for Change under Ground Water Certificate No.'s 406-A and 6508-A

Dear Ms. Holloway:

In response to your request, you are hereby granted an extension to complete construction for the reason(s) below:

According to your request, this project has not been developed due to rezoning of the place of use, which may alter development. In addition, the poor economy has limited your ability to develop the project. It appears you have made minimal progress in completing your project. Be advised that the State Water Code requires that your project be pursued with diligence and does not allow, through the permitting process, the reservation of water for use at an unspecified time in the future. It is important that development of your project continue within the time prescribed in the authorization. Your request is for a reasonable and short period of time. We will grant you an additional four years to complete your project. The project will be reevaluated at that time for compliance with due diligence.

The new deadline to submit your *Construction Notice* is **April 1, 2016**.

An approved measuring device must be installed and maintained for each of the sources identified by this water right in accordance with the rule "Requirements for Measuring and Reporting Water Use", WAC 173-173, which describes the requirements for data accuracy, device installation and operation, and information reporting. It also allows a water user to petition the Department of Ecology for modifications to some of the requirements.

Water use data shall be recorded weekly and maintained by the property owner for a minimum of five years. The maximum rate of diversion/withdrawal and the annual total volume shall be submitted to the Department of Ecology by January 31st of each calendar year.

Recorded water use data shall be submitted via the Internet. To set up an Internet reporting account, contact the Eastern Regional Office. If you do not have Internet access, you can still submit hard copies by contacting the Eastern Regional Office for forms to submit your water use data.



The water right holder must file the notice of Proof of Appropriation of water (under which the *certificate of change* is issued) when the permanent distribution system has been constructed and the quantity of water required by the project has been put to full beneficial use. The *certificate of change* will reflect the extent of the project perfected within the limitations of the water right change authorization. Elements of a proof inspection may include, as appropriate, the source(s), system instantaneous capacity, beneficial use(s), annual quantity, place of use, and satisfaction of provisions.

Department of Ecology personnel, upon presentation of proper credentials, shall have access at reasonable times, to the project location, and to inspect at reasonable times, records of water use, wells, diversions, measuring devices and associated distribution systems for compliance with water law.

YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this action to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this document. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal, you must do the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this document:

- File your appeal and a copy of this document with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this document on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) Email is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
