Dear Mr. Scofield:

In response to your request, you are hereby granted an extension to put the water to full beneficial use for the reason(s) below:

- Financing is delayed due to a recent Chapter 11 Bankruptcy filing.

The new deadline to submit your *Proof of Appropriation of Water* is **December 1, 2013**.

New Provisions: According to Ecology's Provision *POL-1050*, "As a condition of an extension, Ecology may require additional provisions and conditions . . . "As a condition of this extension approval, Ecology is requiring the following new provisions:

- Schedules and Inspections: Department of Ecology personnel, upon presentation of proper credentials, must have access at reasonable times, to the records of water use that are kept to meet the above conditions, and to inspect at reasonable times any measuring device used to meet the above conditions.
- Record Weekly, Report Annual Totals: Recorded water use data shall be submitted via the Internet. To set up an Internet reporting account, contact the Region Office. If you do not have Internet access, you can still submit hard copies by contacting the Region Office for forms to submit your water use data.
- Electronic Reporting: Recorded water use data shall be submitted via the Internet. To set up an Internet reporting account, contact the Central Regional Office Regional Office. If you do not have Internet access, you can still submit hard copies by contacting the Central Regional Office Regional Office for forms to submit your water use data.
- A map outlining which orchards and number of acres that are being irrigated under this Permit, as it overlaps with Permit No. S4-30541P and S4-30544P, and indicate on the map what remains to be done.



YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:

- File your appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this decision on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
