Dear Ms. Detweiler and Mr. Clowes:

**Re: Request for Temporary Water Use Application No. S1-28681**

The Department of Ecology (Ecology) received your application requesting temporary withdrawal of surface water. The source of the water will be from a Seattle Public Utilities outflow pipe that runs across your parcel of land in Seattle, WA and flows directly into Puget Sound. The request is for 0.033 cubic feet per second (cfs) of water to irrigate your undeveloped lot, approximately 1.2 acres.

This lot will be planted with native northwestern plant species and placed in a permanent easement with the Cascade Land Conservancy. Ecology is committed to support projects that protect natural spaces in rural areas. According to RCW 90.54.020(3), the quality of the natural environment shall be protected, and where possible, enhanced. This project is in the public interest.

The plans and conservation activities pertaining to this lot are permitted by the Seattle Department of Planning and Development. The diversion of the water from the Seattle Public Utilities drainpipe has been approved as well.

Your request for temporary use of this water is approved. The duration of water use is authorized from the date of this letter through September 30, 2011.

### **YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL**

You have a right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:

- File your appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this decision on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
