Re: Water Right Change Authorization Nos. CS2-SWC2643, CS2-21810, CS2-21811,
and CG2-26836(A) for Briggs Well Project

Dear Ms. Hoenig:

In response to your request, you are hereby granted an extension to begin construction for the reasons below:

- The magnitude of the Briggs Well municipal supply project requires considerable time for planning and coordination with the City of Olympia's other water supply projects.
- The City demonstrates due diligence in planning for development under these change authorizations. Progress includes obtaining an easement for the project, drilling a bore hole, water quality testing and scoping for the 2015-2020 Water System Plan update.
- Source development options, future demand, treatment costs and source needs will be evaluated and addressed in the next water system plan update due in June, 2016.

The current Beginning of Construction due date for the above-referenced change authorizations is May 1, 2014. You requested a five-year extension of that date.

Your new deadline to begin construction and submit a *Construction Notice* is **May 1, 2019**. However, as a condition of granting this five-year extension, you must report progress made on the City's Water System Plan update by **June 1, 2016**.

YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).



To appeal you must do the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:
File your appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.

- Serve a copy of your appeal and this decision on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.


