Dear Mr. Senner:

In response to your request, you are hereby granted an extension to put the water to full beneficial use for the reasons below:

- Due diligence is shown in development of this permit. The Manzanita Beach water system is actively serving 34 services.
- Additional time is needed to develop remaining lots and achieve full beneficial use of water due to variable development plans of individual lot owners.

The new deadline to submit your *Proof of Appropriation of Water* or request another permit extension is **November 1, 2020**.

A review of data submittals for this system indicates that there has been no increase in chloride levels since you began monitoring in 1999. Because the system is close to full build-out and not exhibiting any signs of seawater intrusion, we are decreasing the monitoring requirement to once every two years, with sampling required during the month of October. Since sampling occurred this year, the next test will not be due until 2017. However, please continue to report source metering data on-line by January 31st, each year.

YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:

- File your appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.



- Serve a copy of your appeal and this decision on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.


You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
