**Re: Water Right Nos. CS4-SWC1175@1 and CS4-SWC1176@1**

Dear Ms. Hegy:

In response to your request, you are hereby granted an extension to put the water to full beneficial use for the reason(s) below:

The Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife has been working with Ecology and the Conservation Commission on a proposal to change several aspects of the above referenced water rights through the Irrigation Efficiencies Grant Program (or by other means). Information provided by Jack Myrick of the Conservation Commission indicates that there were documented issues with sedimentation in the ponds authorized as source locations in 2003, and that this has led to an unavailability of water that was problematic in resolving. The result has been a delay in WDFW's ability to put the water to beneficial use in the manner stated on the change authorizations. The aforementioned change applications seek to remedy this problem by moving the authorized point of diversion to a new well and changing the delivery system and place of use to allow water to be applied in a more efficient manner.

The new deadline to submit your *Proof of Appropriation of Water* is **November 30, 2013**.

#### **YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL**

You have a right to appeal this Decision to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Decision. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Decision:

- File your appeal and a copy of this Decision with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this Decision on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.



You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
