CONSUMPTIVE USE CALCULATION: The consumptive use is 18.11 inches per acre based on the Cle Elum station of the Washington Irrigation Guide for pasture.
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NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT: The authorized points of diversion are: POD "A" located in the NW ¹ / ₄ SE ¹ / ₄ of Section 36, and POD "B" located in the SE ¹ / ₄ SW ¹ / ₄ of Section 36, both in T. 21 N., R. 17 E.W.M. The applicant proposes to change the points of diversion to a single point located on the applicant's property in the NW ¹ / ₄ NE ¹ / ₄ of Section 1, T. 20 N., R. 17 E.W.M. and change from open ditch to sprinkler irrigation.
