<p>NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT: THE AUTHORIZED POINT OF DIVERSION OF THE RIGHT AS IT PRESENTLY EXISTS IS WITHIN THE NE¼NW¼SE¼ OF SECTION 12, T. 18 N., R. 17 E.W.M., KITTITAS COUNTY.</p> <p>THE APPLICANT PROPOSES TO CHANGE THE POINT OF DIVERSION FOR A PORTION OF THE WATER RIGHT TO A WELL FIELD OF NOT MORE THAN FOUR WELLS LOCATED IN THE E½SW¼SW¼, THE E½NW¼SW¼, THE E½SW¼NW¼, AND E½NW¼NW¼; ALL IN SECTION 5, T. 9 N., R. 27 E.W.M., BENTON COUNTY.</p> <p>THE APPLICANT PROPOSES TO CHANGE THE PLACE OF USE FOR A PORTION OF THE WATER RIGHT TO 192 ACRES WITHIN PORTIONS OF THE E½SW¼NW¼, THE NW¼NW¼, THE E½NW¼ OF SECTION 5; THE E½NE¼NE¼, THE W½NE¼NE¼, THE NE¼NW¼, THE NW¼NE¼, THE SE¼NE¼, AND THE SW¼NE¼ OF SECTION 9; THE E½SE¼SE¼ OF SECTION 4, ALL IN T. 9 N., R. 27 E.W.M., BENTON COUNTY.</p> <p>THE APPLICANT PROPOSES TO CHANGE A PORTION OF THE RIGHT SET FORTH ABOVE IN THE INSTANTANEOUS AND ANNUAL QUANTITIES HEREBEFORE SET FORTH IN THE AMOUNTS OF UP TO 3.72 CFS AND 250.8 AF.</p> <p>THE APPLICANT PROPOSES TO ADD AN ADDITIONAL PURPOSE OF USE TO INSTREAM FLOW USE RELATED TO THE YAKIMA RIVER WITH A REACH BEGINNING APPROXIMATELY FOUR MILES NORTH OF ELLENSBURG AND ENDING APPROXIMATELY TWO MILES DOWNSTREAM FROM THE BENTON CITY BRIDGE</p>

OVER THE RIVER. THE KITTITAS COUNTY WATER CONSERVANCY BOARD, IN ITS PROCESSING, INCLUDED A SECOND ELEMENT OF INSTREAM FLOW USE WHICH BEGINS APPROXIMATELY TWO MILES UPSTREAM FROM THE CONFLUENCE OF REECER CREEK AND THE YAKIMA RIVER AND THEREAFTER DOWNSTREAM TO THE AFOREMENTIONED BENTON CITY AREA.

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
