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<p>NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:</p> <p>The Yakima Adjudication Court confirmed Vernon & Jo Marie Carson, Laddy Vibbert, Loren Wiley, and Joe Wiley an 1870 priority date water right under court claim number 0370 and 02398 in Subbasin 23 (Ahtanum Creek). David Carson currently owns property in a portion of the place of use listed on the claim.</p> <p>In 2004 David Carson applied to add a point of diversion for a portion of the right on Hatton Creek located within the NW¼NE¼ of Section 17, T. 12 N., R. 17 E.W.M.</p> <p>Both the senior and junior water rights are confirmed to divert water from the same points on Bachelor Creek located within the NE¼NE¼ and NW¼NW¼ of Section 17; the NE¼SW¼ and a point located 200 feet south and 300 feet east from the center of Section 8, being within the NW¼ SE¼ of Section 8, all in t. 12 N., R. 17 E.W.M. The junior right can only be exercised when the flow in Ahtanum Creek exceeds 62.59 cfs <u>and</u> no uses are being made of the excess by water right holders on the reservation.</p> <p>The Yakima Adjudication Court, in its Report of the Court for Subbasin No. 23 (Ahtanum Creek), confirmed the same points of diversion that were certified in the previous 1925 Ahtanum Creek Adjudication. However, many water right holders are now using different points of diversion (e.g., pump sites) that were never authorized</p>

through the water right change process outlined in RCW 90.03.380. The purpose of the application described above is to request authorization for an additional point of diversion, one currently used today, under the original right.
