NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT: <p>The Yakima Adjudication Court confirmed Joe Wiley, Brian Helle, and Charles and Nan Eaton an 1888 priority date water right under court claim number 2398 in Subbasin 23 (Ahtanum Creek). Bruce Ball currently owns property in a portion of the place of use listed on the claim.</p> <p>In 2005, Bruce Ball applied to add a point of diversion on Ahtanum Creek for a portion of the right, located within the SE¼NE¼ of Section 16, T. 12 N., R. 17 E.W.M.</p> <p>The right is currently authorized to divert water from two points on Ahtanum Creek, located within the NE¼NE¼ of Section 17 and Government Lot 2 of Section 16, T. 12 N., R. 17 E.W.M.</p> <p>The Yakima Adjudication Court, in its Report of the Court for Subbasin No. 23 (Ahtanum Creek), confirmed the same points of diversion that were certified in the previous 1925 Ahtanum Creek Adjudication. However, many water right holders are now using different points of diversion (e.g., pumpsites) that were never authorized through the water right change process outlined in RCW 90.03.380. The purpose of the</p>

application described above is to request authorization for an additional point of diversion, one currently used today, under the original right.
