<p>PERIOD OF USE:</p> <p>A combined instantaneous diversion not to exceed 150 cubic feet per second and annual quantity 50,075 is divided among the Cascade Irrigation District's points of diversion as follows:</p> <p>Yakima River 150 cubic feet per second, 33,025 acre feet from April 1 to July 20, for irrigation of 12,446.3 acres and stock water; 150 cubic feet per second, 16,800 acre feet from July 21 through October 15, for irrigation of 12,446.3 acres and stock water.</p> <p>Yakima River 10 cubic feet per second, 250 acre feet (consumptive use) from October 16 through March 31 for stock water.</p> <p>Yakima River (Buck Diversion) 0.05 cubic feet per second, 8 acre feet for irrigation for 2 acres from April 1 through October 15.</p> <p>Currier/Reecer 7.05 cubic feet per second, 628 acre feet from April 1 to July 20, and 13 acre feet from July 21 to October 15 for irrigation and stock water.</p> <p>Lyle Creek 10 cubic feet per second, 1,117 acre feet from April 1 to July 20, and 20 acre feet from July 21 to October 15 for irrigation and stock water.</p>	

Naneum Creek 17.52 cubic feet per second, 917 acre feet from April 1 to July 20, and 1 acre foot from July 21 to August 15 for irrigation and stock water.

Coleman Creek 25 cubic feet per second, 1,962 acre feet from April 1 to July 20, and 40 acre feet from July 21 to September 30 for irrigation and stock water.

Caribou Creek 30 cubic feet per second, 1,225 acre feet from April 1 to July 20, and 16 acre feet from July 21 to October 15 for irrigation and stock water.

Parke Creek 7.87 cubic feet per second, 333 acre feet from April 1 to July 20, and 20 acre feet from July 21 to September 30 for irrigation and stock water.

Badger Creek 15.6 cubic feet per second, 1,552 acre feet from April 1 to July 20, and 43 acre feet from July 21 to August 31 for irrigation and stock water.

**Description and Purpose of Requested Change**

Cascade Irrigation District (CID) is proposing to add one point of diversion to the existing five points of diversion from the Yakima River authorized within Yakima Adjudication Court Claim Nos. 00981 and 02800. The point of diversion will be located between the existing Clark Flat and Strawberry flat points of diversion. The Yakima Adjudication Court recommended that CID submit a change application with Ecology to add this point of diversion. The proposed point of diversion has been used to supply irrigation water for the two acres referred to as the Buck property and diverts 0.05 cfs, 8 acre feet per year. The 0.05 cfs is part of the total cfs confirmed in the Conditional Final Order and not an additional quantity.
