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<p>NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:</p> <p>The USBR purchased this property on 8-06-03 with Yakima River Basin Water Enhancement Project Water and Land Acquisition Program funds for the purpose of fallowing the land and transferring the irrigation & stock water right to instream flow enhancement use in the Yakima River below the authorized point of diversion and then downstream in the Yakima River to its confluence with the Columbia River.</p> <p>USBR is seeking Court Order Pendente Lite transfer of this water right immediately to instream flow use and will later seek transfer of this water right to the State Trust Water Rights Program for instream flow enhancement use.</p> <p>USBR and Ecology are currently negotiating an MOA on joint management of State Trust Water Rights in the Yakima Basin.</p>
