PLACE OF USE: The <b>primary reach</b> begins at the historical point of diversion on the Yakima River located 500 feet S and 850 feet E from the center of Section 12, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, T18N R17E W.M.  The <b>secondary reach</b> begins on the Yakima River located approximately 2,280 feet south and 840 feet west of the northeast corner of Section 19 T. 18 N., R. 18 E. W.M. and ends at the confluence of the Yakima and Columbia rivers in Wallula Lake located approximately 2130 feet north and 770 feet east of the southwest corner of Section 17, T. 9 N., R 29 E. W.M.		PURPOSE OF USE: This trust water right will be placed in the State Trust Water Right Program (TWRP) for instream flow purposes and mitigation for the City of Roslyn's out-of-priority water use on Domerie Creek.
IRRIGATION METHOD: Historically Flood

NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT: The City of Roslyn proposes to change the purpose and place of use of Surface Water Right CS4-00521CTCLsb7 owned by City of Roslyn, and to convey the water right to the Washington State Trust Water Right Program (TWRP). Placing CS4-00521CTCLsb7 into the TWRP will provide mitigation for the out-of-priority use of the City's existing Domerie Creek water right when pro-rationing of May 10, 1905 water rights is imposed. When the City has full use of its Domerie Creek Water right, the trust water right will be left in the TWRP for instream flow purposes or may be transferred to other out of stream uses.
