CONSUMPTIVE USE CALCULATION:

Consumptive use is based on the Washington Irrigation Guide crop irrigation requirement (CIR) estimate for Pasture/Turf in the Ellensburg, WA region. The average CIR for Pasture/Turf is 31.46 inches per acre annually (WIG season includes May-October). In 20 years of donation, from April 1 through October 15, Jack Wadkins will be following 3.15 acres under this water right.

NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

WWT is requesting to change Jack Wadkins Court Claim to instream flow. Jack Wadkins has 50% interest in 6.30 acres of Court Claim No. 1207 on Klocke Ditch. The current landowners, Lee and Karen Bates, will follow 3.15 acres of Irrigation on their existing 6.30 acre irrigated field. WWT is assisting Mr. Wadkins in donating his water right into the Washington State Trust Water Right Program for a period of 20 years.
