**NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:**

The Kittitas County Conservation District is working with Teanaway River irrigators on the 3 M Ditch to eliminate the diversion and the need to use the ditch. This applicant is one of the 3 M Ditch irrigators.


The applicant proposes to move his authorized point-of diversion on the Teanaway River 5000 feet downstream.

The applicants authorized point of diversion is the former 3 M Ditch diversion which was washed out in January of 2009. The bank of the Teanaway River was badly eroded making it impossible to replace the 3 M Ditch diversion without a significant amount of instream work. The 3 M Ditch is the last known push up dam on the mainstem of the Teanaway River and has often created a fish passage barrier during the lower flow periods of the irrigation season. The Kittitas County Conservation District has been contacted for technical and financial assistance.

The new river diversion will be accomplished using a portable pump with a screened intake.

The applicant is seeking no other changes to his water right.
