


Figure 1: Location of the POU for WBN request G4-35719. Suitability zones for Recer Creek Water Bank are shown by color overlays.

<p>NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:</p> <p>Parcel No. 952180, in the green suitability zone for the Reecer Creek water bank, is located in the NW¼ of Section 33, T17N, R20E. The Parcel is approximately 5 miles southeast of the City of Kittitas and 1.3 miles northeast of Badger Creek (Figure 1).</p> <p>The requestor proposes to offset the 0.148 afy of consumptive use for the project (two residential connections) with 0.148 afy of mitigation water acquired from Trust Water Right No. CS4-01724CTCSsb7.</p>

Location Map for G4-35719
