If yes, explain why you are unable to connect to the system: Deep River Camp is within the service area of the Western Wahkiakum Water system, but due to the high cost of connecting to this system, the local residents are unable to afford the fees and connection cost to this size of project. The estimated cost of connecting to this system is well over \$1 million. Deep River Camp has temporary approval from Health Department at this diversion point. This is allowed to be used until a Water Rights Permit is obtained or until the Western Wahkiakum P.U.D. Water system is connected to our property.
