

- (6) The legal metes-and-bound description of your land is part of your deed or purchase contract. Use this, or part of this, as explained below. DO NOT USE THE LEGAL DESCRIPTION FROM A TAX STATEMENT OR TAX LOT DESCRIPTION. If the place of use of water is considerably less than the total lands you own, modify your legal description so as to delete from it the (large) areas upon which water is not being used. For example: If you own the W 1/2 of Section 4, but only irrigate the NW 1/4NW 1/4, you should accordingly state the place of use to be the NW 1/4NW 1/4 of Section 4. The legal description must include section, township, range and county. If additional space is needed to furnish this legal description of place of use, attach a sheet of paper to this claim and complete the legal description on that attached sheet (one copy is sufficient). If the Water Right Claim is for more than one property ownership, separate legal descriptions of each place of use must be noted, together with proper identification of ownership of each tract.
- (7) Examples of purpose(s) of use include, but are not limited to, the following: domestic supply, municipal supply, commercial use, industrial use, irrigation, stock water, power generation and fish propagation. If used for more than one purpose, show all purposes for which used. If used for domestic supply, include statement of number of homes served. If used for industrial purposes, specify type of operations. For example: refrigeration, gravel washing, etc.
- (8) State the basic legal doctrine (appropriation or riparian) under which the claimed right has been established. If the doctrine is statutory, cite the statute. If the claim is based on a court decree, cite the cause number, date of decree and name of court.



If such additional data is available for public record purposes, please so signify. This office will subsequently forward a separate form for your use in providing the technical data for inclusion in our basic data section as a part of our continuing program of basic data collection.
