Beginning at a point S 63°36' W, 526 feet from the intersection of the south line of the W. & C.R.R. right of way and the east line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 12, T. 9 N., R. 37 E.W.M.; thence S 63°36' W along said right of way 1438 feet; thence S 0°53' E 566 feet to the middle of the Washington Mill Race; thence up the middle of said mill race to the west line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 12; thence N 0°03' W on said W line 274 feet; thence N 85°44' E 866.67 feet; thence N 825 feet to the place of beginning and containing 19 acres, more or less, all being in Sec. 12, T. 9 N., R. 37 E.W.M., Walla Walla County.

PROVISIONS

1. This superseding certificate changes the point of diversion as provided by Chapter 90.03.280 RCW and supersedes Certificate of Water Right recorded in Vol. 6 of Water Right Certificates at Page 64, dated March 17, 1930 and was issued by a decree of the Superior Court of the State of Washington in and for Columbia County, made and entered on the 19th day of September 1929 and recorded in Volume "N" of the Superior Court Journal of said county at Page 419. The decree determined the rights of all known claimants to the use of the waters of the Touchet River, a tributary to the Walla Walla River.
2. After all rights mentioned in the above-mentioned decree are filled, the surplus water is allotted in the order of priority in amount sufficient to increase rate to the quantity allotted for the period from September 15 to April 1. The total diversion shall not exceed 6 acre feet for any one year beginning September 15.
3. The above-mentioned decree establishes this right in Class 3.
4. The above-named is also entitled to water for stock and domestic use to the extent of .01 cubic feet per second, from a spring rising on his property, without consideration of priority of other water rights involved in the above-mentioned decree.


The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380, 90.03.390, and 90.44.020.

This certificate of water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as provided in RCW 90.14.160.
