
PROVISIONS

1. This superseding certificate adds a point of diversion as provided by Chapter 90.03.380 RCW and supersedes Certificate of Water Right recorded in Vol. 4 of Water Right Certificates at Page 33, dated June 29, 1929 and was issued by a decree of the Superior Court of the State of Washington in and for Walla Walla County, made and entered on the 12th day of September 1928 and recorded in Volume 16 of the Superior Court Journal of said county at Page 1. The decree determined the rights of all known claimants to the use of the waters of Yellowhawk Creek tributary to the Walla Walla River.
2. If water is used during the last named period (October 1 to April 1) in addition to either or both of the two first named periods, the combined supply shall not exceed five (5) acre feet per acre.
3. The above-mentioned Decree establishes this Right in Class 5.
4. This change does not affect any element of this water right except those changes specifically authorized by and set forth in this certificate.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380, 90.03.390, and 90.44.020.

This certificate of water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as provided in RCW 90.14.160.
