**CERTIFICATE OF CHANGE VOL 1-4, PAGE 319, TO CHANGE THE POINT OF
DIVERSION UNDER WENAS CREEK ADJUDICATED CERTIFICATE NO. 13.**

IN accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90.03 and 90.44 of the Revised Code of Washington (RCW) and the regulations of the Department of Ecology:

This is to certify that Loren and Patricia Kjeldgaard of Selah, Washington are hereby granted the right to:

Change the point of diversion under Wenas Creek Adjudicated Certificate No. 13. Said certificate was confirmed in the 1921 adjudication of surface water of Wenas Creek, and again recommended for confirmation in the ongoing Yakima River Basin Adjudication. That portion of said authorization for Loren and Patricia Kjeldgaard confirms a use of 0.035 cubic feet per second, 5.25 acre-feet per year for irrigation of 1.75 acres. (Parcel #181412 33005)

The authorized point of diversion was located in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, T. 14 N., R. 18 E.W.M., Yakima County.


This Certificate of Change authorizes the Kjeldgaard's change of point of diversion of the confirmed quantity of water to the location described below:

A point of diversion located approximately 330 feet north and 900 feet east of the southwest corner of Section 12, being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, T. 14 N., R. 18 E.W.M., Yakima County. (Parcel #181412 33005)

All provisions of the right remain as required and confirmed in the Second Supplemental Report of Referee, Subbasin 15, Re: Subbasin 15, and subject to the recommendations of the Conditional Final Order, Subbasin 15.

Final issuance of an Adjudicated Certificate of Water Right in the Yakima River Basin Adjudication should reflect this change in point of diversion. Upon issuance of the final decree and adjudicated certificates, it is expected that the court will make all previous state issued surface water documents null and void.


