

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify:-

That a decree of the Superior Court in and for Yakima County, State of Washington, made and entered on the 23rd day of February, 1921, copy of which is on file in the office of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of the State of Washington, adjudicated the rights of **WILLIAM L. OGBURN, Selah, Wn., RFD. 1** in and to the waters of Wenas Creek and its tributaries in said county and state, for beneficial use, as follows:-

0.58 Second Feet (29.2 miners inches under 4 inch pressure) of Class 2 water, upon 29.2 acres of the lands hereinafter described, subject to the following conditions:-

This right to share equally with rights in class 3, amounting to 4.0 second feet.

Classes 3 to 12 inclusive except 3.00 sec. ft. for 150 acres in class 8; 0.08 sec. ft. for 4 acres in class 9, 0.14 sec. ft. for 7 acres in class 10 and 2.23 sec. ft. for 111.6 acres in class 11, share equally with the following in class 2: Cleman Dairy Co. 2.5 sec. ft. for 124.91 acres and R. F. Taylor 0.72 sec. ft. for 35.8 acres.

All rights within a class are equal and in the event of there being insufficient water to supply all within a given class, the supply is to be prorated according to the acreage.

All riparian owners are entitled to the uninterrupted flow of the water in Wenas Creek in excess of the total amount set forth in the appended schedule (decree) when the same can be beneficially applied to land under the findings. The waters of any unprecedented or extraordinary flood which cannot be beneficially used on riparian lands belong to the public and are subject to appropriation.

That the point of diversion of said water right is as follows: in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 9 Twp 14 N. R 18 E. W. M. and cannot be changed except as provided in Section 39, Chapter 117, Session Laws of 1917.

That said water right is appurtenant to the following described real property situated in Yakima County, Washington, to-wit:-
